It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-21 of the General Laws entitled "Health and Safety of Pupils" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>16-21-37. Availability of feminine hygiene products.</u>
- 4 (a) By the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year, all public schools maintaining any
- 5 <u>combination of classes from grade six (6) through grade twelve (12), inclusive, shall make feminine</u>
- 6 <u>hygiene products available in the school as follows:</u>
- 7 (1) Feminine products shall be available in all gender-neutral bathrooms and any bathroom
- 8 <u>designated for females;</u>
- 9 (2) Feminine products shall be available at no cost to students.
- 10 (b) For the purposes of this section, "feminine hygiene products" includes tampons and
- 11 <u>sanitary napkins.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 13-5 of the General Laws entitled "Station Houses for Women" is
- 13 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 14 <u>13-5-11. Availability of feminine hygiene products.</u>
- 15 (a) Beginning January 1, 2022, feminine hygiene products shall be made available to all
- 16 <u>female inmates at no cost to the inmate.</u>
- 17 (b) For the purposes of this section, "feminine hygiene products" includes tampons and
- 18 <u>sanitary napkins.</u>

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
