AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 15-120.04; APPROPRIATING MONIES; RELATING TO STUDENT
HEALTH.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 1, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-120.04, to read:
4 15-120.04. Feminine hygiene products; required provision by
5 schools; definition
6 A. A SCHOOL THAT IS OPERATED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL
7 AND THAT SERVES STUDENTS IN ANY OF GRADES SIX THROUGH TWELVE SHALL MAKE
8 FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS AVAILABLE IN ALL WOMEN'S AND GENDER-NEUTRAL
9 RESTROOMS IN THE SCHOOL. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, A SCHOOL THAT
10 PROVIDES FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION MAY NOT CHARGE
11 A STUDENT OR THE FAMILY OF A STUDENT FOR A FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCT.
12 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS"
13 INCLUDES TAMPONS AND SANITARY NAPKINS.
14 Sec. 2. Appropriation; department of education; feminine
15 hygiene products
16 The sum of \$800,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
17 fiscal year 2023-2024 to the department of education to distribute to
18 school districts and charter schools to provide feminine hygiene products
19 as prescribed in section 15-120.04, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by
20 this act.
