2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6404 is enacted to read:
3	§6404. Access to menstrual products
4 5 6 7	A school administrative unit shall require all schools that serve students in grades 6 to 12 to make available menstrual products to students at no cost in all school bathrooms. For purposes of this section, "menstrual product" means tampons and pads used with respect to menstruation.
