

MICHIGAN SB 173 Making a Difference in Student Lives

- Senate Bill 173 sets aside \$1 million for the year 2023-2024 from the state school aid fund. This money is specifically designated to help schools in urban, suburban, and rural areas across the state. The main goal of this funding is to make sure that students who need them can easily get feminine hygiene products like tampons and menstrual pads.
 - a. \$1 million to provide eligible students with free pads or tampons.
 - Each eligible student shall receive a minimum of 20 tampons or pads each month for the school year.
- 2. **Qualifications:** Funds are awarded to districts in urban, suburban, and rural areas in the state to eligible students within the district.

3. Timeline: October 1, 2023
